Georgia Law (O.C.G.A. Section 3-3-7) states:

“The sale of alcoholic beverages is lawful for consumption on the premises on Sundays from 12:30 p.m. until 12:00 midnight in any licensed establishment derives at least 50 percent of its total annual gross sales from the sale of prepared meals or food in all the combined retail outlets of the individual establishment where food is served and in any licensed establishment which derives at least 50 percent of its total annual gross income from rental of rooms for overnight lodging.”

By submitting this application for a Sunday Sales Permit, the applicant certifies that their business establishment will operate in compliance with the “The Gross Sales” provisions of Georgia Law and Barrow County Ordinance as cited above for the calendar year licensed. Sunday sales permit holders are subject to audit for compliance with State Law. Each establishment is encouraged to maintain financial records on food sales and alcohol sales by separate business location to demonstrate compliance with State Law.
