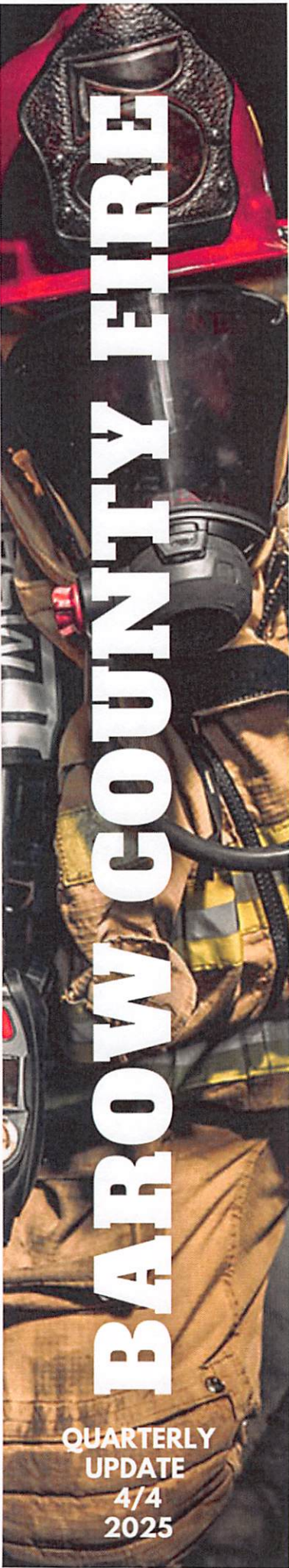

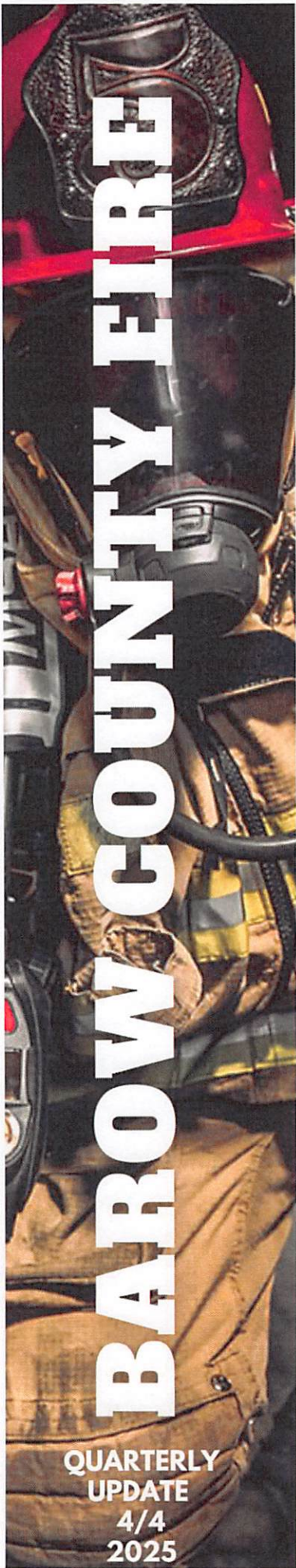

Our team presented on Barrow County's Integrated Response Model for Rescue Task Force operations, showcasing how fire, EMS, and law enforcement work together during critical incidents.

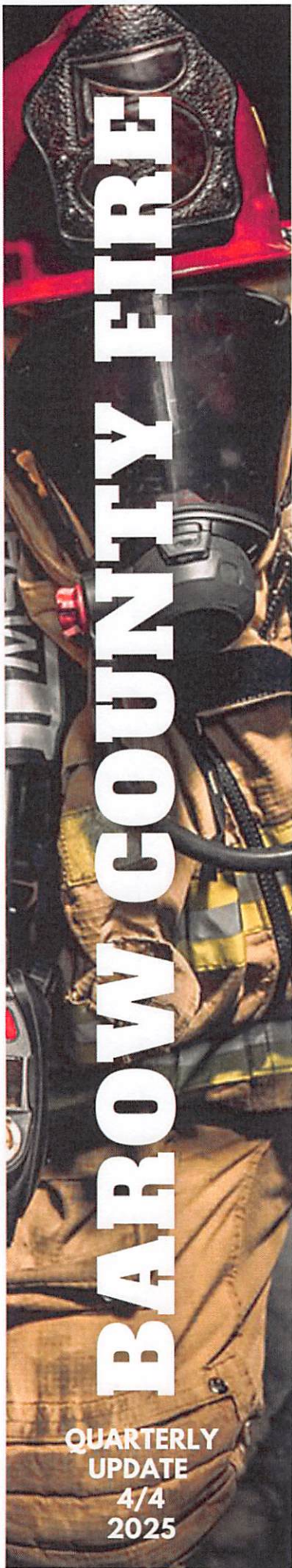

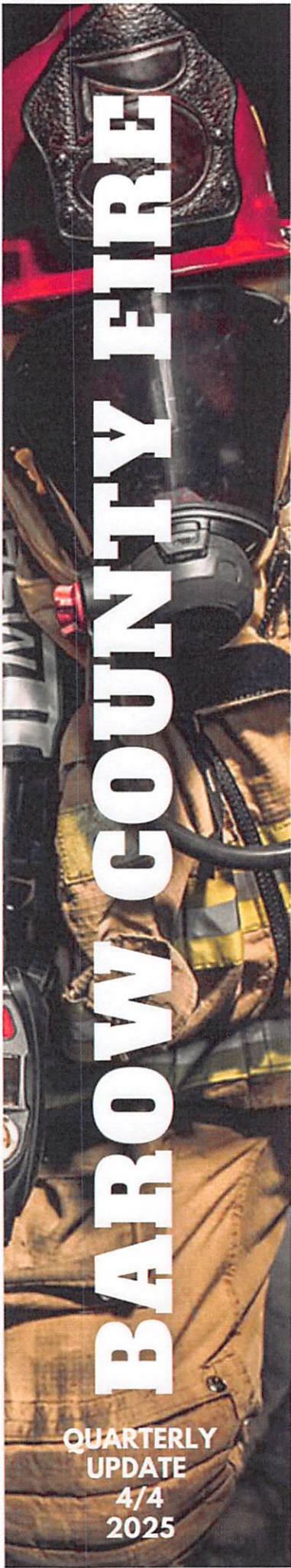
