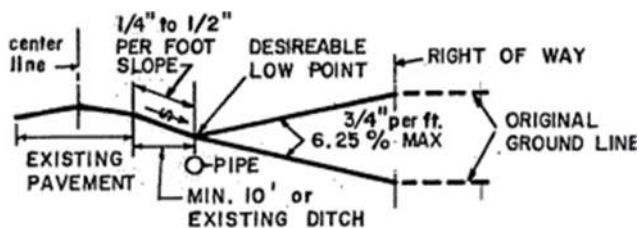
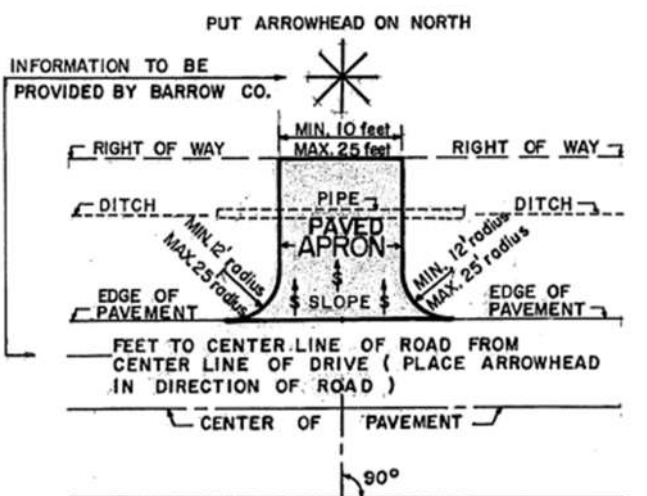

Special Requirements

1. Extend pipe as necessary to obtain a 4:1 or flatter slope.
2. The pipe shall be GDOT standard 1030D. (and as specified in the Barrow County Development Regulations **20' minimum**) _____ ft in width _____ inches in diameter. Minimum 1' of cover over pipe.
3. Existing surface flow to remain. Water cannot be diverted to Barrow County right-of-way.
4. No headwalls to be constructed on pipe.
5. No brick or other hazardous type mailbox allowed on right-of-way. (Mailbox shall be located on the exit side) All driveways should have a turnaround pad off right-of-way to prevent backing into the road.
6. All disturbed right-of-way to be regraded to Barrow County specifications.
7. If driveway is used for construction entrance, it must be stabilized with 4' of stone as a minimum.
8. The green permit poster must be displayed at the proposed driveway location in plain view until work is inspected and accepted by Barrow County. **This poster is NOT an approved permit.**
9. Applicant to give Barrow County Driveway inspector a 24-hour notice before work begins and before each phase of construction.
10. Advance warning signs shall be required while working on Barrow County right-of-way.
11. Driveways on a dirt road shall have 4' of gravel placed on driveway from edge of road to end of road maintenance easement or right-of-way as a minimum.
12. Driveways on a paved road shall have a paved apron. Paved apron material shall consist of either a minimum of 6" of class A 3000p.s.i. concrete, or a minimum of 5" of compacted graded aggregate base and 3" of compacted superpave asphalt. All of the above will be place on a suitable compacted sub-grade. Drive to be flush with existing edge of pavement. (see diagram to the left)
13. Permittee shall be responsible for any damage(s) to existing County road as a result of driveway construction.
14. The inlet and outlet end of all driveway culverts shall have a safety flared-end-sections that meet the standards of GDOT 1120 or 1125 or 1125.
