**Application ACCEPT Dates are for those who do not meet any of the EXCEPTIONS and must re-apply for an absentee ballot each election (See Absentee Ballot Application for exceptions)*

If someone meets any of the EXCEPTIONS, only one application is required per election cycle

You may apply on behalf of another person ONLY in the following circumstances:

In the case of a voter residing temporarily out of the county or a physically disabled voter residing within the county, application may be made by mother, father, grandparent, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, spouse, son, daughter, niece, nephew, grandchild, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brother-in-law or sister-in-law of the age of 18 or over.

- * Absentee Ballot Applications may be submitted in person, by mail, by fax or email
- * You may update your registration online if you have a valid Georgia Driver's License or Georgia issued ID at registertovote.sos.ga.gov
- * **NO VOTING** on the Monday prior to Election Day

- * ELECTION DAY : Vote at your assigned Precinct/Polling Location.....unsure where to go? VISIT: mvp.sos.ga.gov

Any voter registered in Georgia can vote absentee by mail. Just complete an application and mail, fax, email (as an attachment), or drop the application off at your county registrar's office. We urge you to request your mail-in ballot and get it back to your county registrar's office as soon as possible. **Mail-in ballots can be requested no earlier than 78 days prior to the election and no later than the 11th day before the election.** The voted ballot must be received by your county registrar no later than close of the polls on Election Day.
